### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

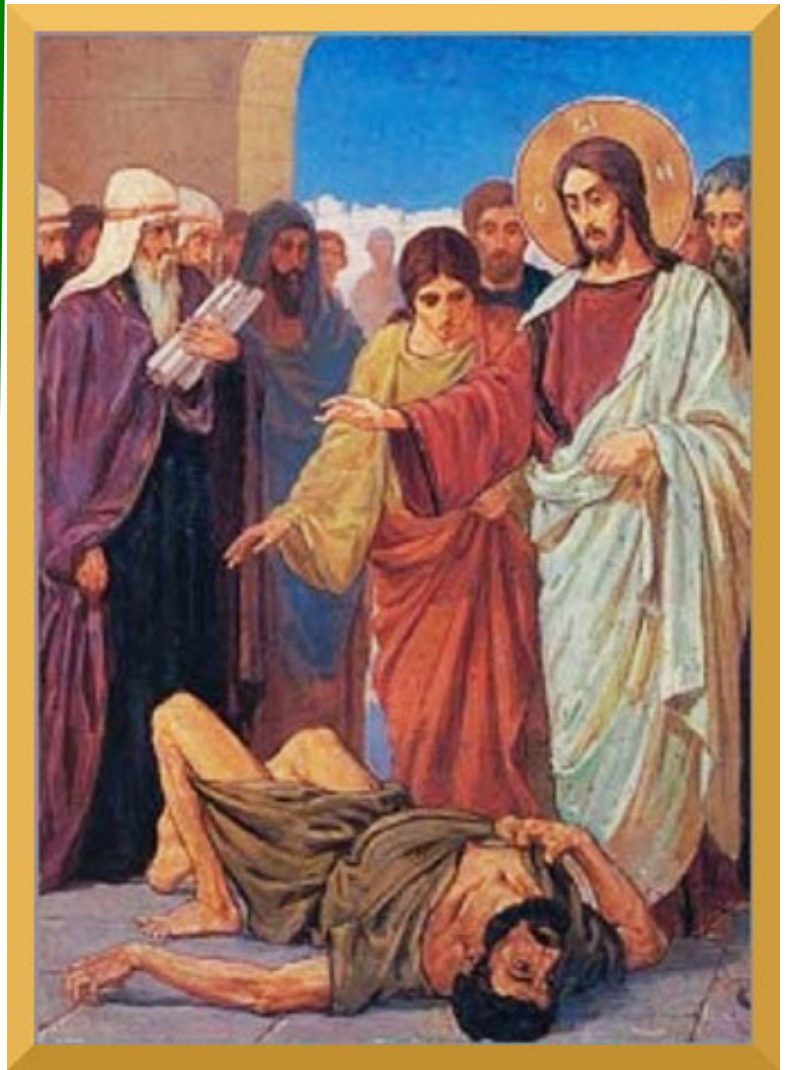

## LITURGY OF THE WORD

In the first reading, the Lord promises Israel that he will raise up a new prophet, one who will speak with his authority. Paul urges the Corinthians to remain free of worldly anxieties. In Mark's Gospel, it is the unclean spirit that recognizes Jesus' true identity and responds to his commands.

## TRUE PROPHETS

In Deuteronomy today we hear that God's very words will fill the mouth of a true prophet, but a false prophet will, in a manner of speaking, put mere mortal words into God's mouth. In Mark's Gospel, we see Jesus teaching and healing as a true prophet, one filled with the authority of God's own voice. The whole history of our church is filled with both true and false prophets. Some false prophets were extremely popular and quite well-versed in scripture, and even held positions of authority. But in today's Gospel we learn that Jesus' fame spread because he taught with authority; he wasn't an authority because he was popular or famous. Elsewhere, we also learn from him, in his desert temptation confrontations with Satan, that anyone can quote scripture, even against God's purposes. Today we hear that his authority was not like that of the scribes, who held the official positions of religious authority in his day. Our work is to do our best to discern the true prophets in our midst, and to be true prophets as well. The psalmist tells us how to do this: by not hardening our hearts when God speaks. If we truly listen to God, it will be God's very words filling our mouths.

### Czas jest krótki

Święty Paweł w liście do Koryntian mówi:

**Mówię wam, bracia, czas jest krótki. Trzeba więc, aby ci, którzy mają żony, tak żyli, jakby byli nieżonaci ...**

O co chodzi? Trochę to brzmi: słuchajcie, za chwilę będzie koniec świata, więc nie ma sensu się żenić, płakać, radować, nabywać czy korzystać z życia. Czy św. Paweł się pomylił? Przecież świat istnieje kolejne 2000 lat.

Pan Jezus w dzisiejszej Ewangelii zwraca nam uwagę w dość podobnym tonie:

**Czas się wypełnił i bliskie jest królestwo Boże. Nawracajcie się i wierźcie w Ewangelię!**

Co to znaczy?

Wielu z nas narzeka na brak czasu. W trochę innym kontekście, ale często też mamy poczucie, że czas jest krótki, że czas się wypełnił, a ja znowu z niczym nie mogę zdążyć. Fachowcy od zarządzania mogą nam podpowiedzieć, że problem nie tkwi w braku czasu, a w tym, że źle czasem gospodarujemy.

Czas to wspaniały dar, który otrzymaliśmy od Boga w momencie naszego powołania do życia. To od nas zależy, jak ten dar wykorzystamy. Dobre zarządzanie czasem sprowadza się do tego, że trzeba sobie swoje sprawy prawidłowo poukładać, nadać im hierarchię ważności, wiedzieć, co jest absolutnie priorytetowe, a co można zostawić na później.

Boże proszę Cię, bym pamiętał, że w moim życiu są sprawy ważne, jak moje małżeństwo, jak smutki i radości, jak to, co posiadam, jak dobra świata, ale są też te najważniejsze, jak nawrócenie, jak wiara, jak Twoje słowo. Daj mi, bym potrafił na Twoje wezwanie tak, jak mój Święty Patron — Andrzej Apostoł, nie marnować czasu, a **natychmiast** w każdej chwili swojego życia był gotowy zwrócić się ku Tobie:

**Boże i Zbawco, w Tobie mam nadzieję.**
