### **SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:**

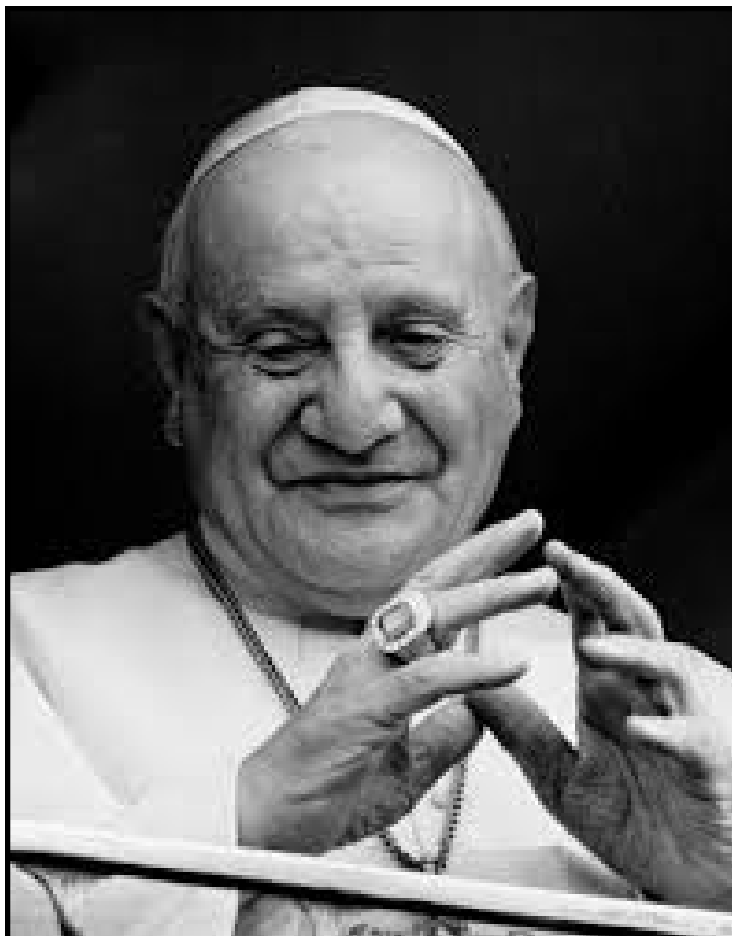

### **BABY'S LIFE BEFORE BIRTH**



My heart is beating at 18-25 days. The foundation for my nervous system is in place at 20 days. My skeleton is complete at 42 days and I have reflexes. My brain waves can be detected as early as 43 days. At 8 weeks my brain and all body systems are present and I look like a miniature doll. During weeks 9 & 10 I squint, swallow and can make a fist. By the 11th and 12th weeks I am moving my arms and legs, sucking my thumbs and breathing amniotic fluid. All my systems are working. My movements by 16 weeks are quite active and I can be seen performing somersaults on ultrasound but am not yet felt by my mother. From the 3rd month on nothing new develops. I continue to grow in size and by 20 weeks I have hair on my head, weigh one pound and am 12 inches tall.

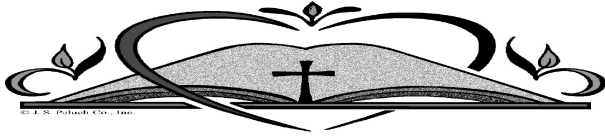

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## **Szaniec bogobojnych**

29 września liturgia wsomina św. archaniołów: Michała, Gabriela i Rafała, a 2 października świętych aniołów stróżów. Z tej okazji warto zastanowić się nad obecnością aniołów w liturgii.

Liturgia, to rzeczywistość, która łączy niebo z ziemią. To rzeczywistość uwielbienia Ojca przez Chrystusa w Duchu Świętym, w którym uczestniczy całe uniwersum: byty widzialne i niewidzialne. Aniołowie, jako istoty niewidzialne, nie są na pierwszym planie tekstów modlitwy Kościoła. Nie mniej jednak są w niej obecne dyskretnie. Oto kilka przykładów.

W każdej Mszy Świętej, kapłan oznajmia: że „z aniołami i wszystkimi świętymi głosimy Twoją chwałę, razem z nimi wołając”: Święty, Święty, Święty. Tzw. Trishagion – „Po trzykroć święty”, to hymn uwielbienia Boga, który usłyszał Izajasz, gdy widział niebo (Iz 6, 3), a później Jan Apostoł w swoim objawieniu (Ap 4, 8). I ważna tu jest kolejność: to nie aniołowie przyłączają się do naszego hymnu, ale my do ich! *Sanctus* wskazuje na ważną cechę liturgii: ona rzeczywiście uobecnia niebo! My naprawdę włączamy się do uwielbienia przez kosmos Trójjedynego!

Słowa aniołów zapożyczamy także w każdą niedzielę. Gdy śpiewamy hymn „Chwała na wysokości Bogu”, nie robimy nic innego, jak naśladujemy aniołów, radujących się z narodzenia Chrystusa (Łk 2, 14). Kościół starożytny tę krótką modlitwę aniołów rozbudował do kształtu, jaki znamy dziś z liturgii, chcąc jak najlepiej wysławiać Boga.

Czasem na Mszy możemy usłyszeć Pierwszą Modlitwę Eucharystyczną (jest ich kilka, ta, o której mowa, nie zawsze jest używana). Po konsekracji, kapłan głęboko pochylony, wypowiada przepiękną modlitwę: „Pokornie Cię błagamy, wszechmogący Boże, niech Twój święty anioł zanieś tę ofiarę na ołtarz w niebie, przed oblicze boskiego majestatu Twego”. Ta starożytna modlitwa ukazuje, że w najważniejszej części liturgii – ofiarowaniu Chrystusa i nas Ojcu – uczestniczą aniołowie. Wszystkie te teksty mają pochodzenie starożytne – wtedy Kościół i ludzie, o wiele bardziej niż dziś, byli wyculeni na rzeczywistość niewidzialną.
