### SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

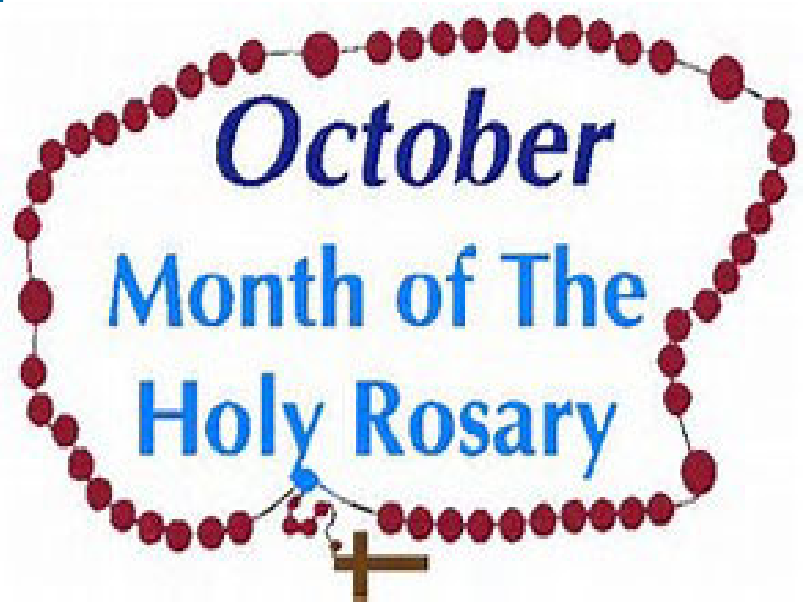

Demografia jest nieubłagana, a elity pełnią funkcje wzorotwórcze. Natura nie znosi próżni i puste miejsce zawsze zajmie ktoś inny. Przekonali się o tym Serbowie w Kosowie. Dr Stojan Adašević, którego odwiedziłem kilka razy w Belgradzie, powiedział mi wprost, że złaicyzowani prawosławni Serbowie przegrali walkę o Kosowo z muzułmańskimi Albańczykami nie na polach bitew, lecz w salach porodowych klinik położniczych. Wystarczyło 50 lat:

Nieprzypadkowo pierwsze błogosławieństwo w Biblii brzmi: „Rozmnażajcie się i czyńcie sobie ziemię poddaną” – przypominał dr Adašević. – Istnieje bowiem zależność między rozmnażaniem się a panowaniem. Kto odmawia prokreacji, ten rezygnuje z panowania nad ziemią. **Ziemia należy do tych, którzy mają pełne kołyski.**

**Podobny punkt widzenia bliski jest wielu muzułmańskim myślicielom, dla których islam to cywilizacja życia, a Zachód – cywilizacja śmierci.** Kilkadziesiąt lat temu brytyjski historyk Arnold J. Toynbee napisał, że cywilizacja zachodnia w krajach Trzeciego Świata wytworzyła z jednej strony ekonomiczną i polityczną pełnię, z drugiej zaś – społeczną i duchową pustkę – i w pustkę tę wchodzi islam. Sami muzułmańscy politycy doskonale zdają sobie z tego sprawę. Dlatego przy każdej okazji prezydent Turcji Recep Tayyip Erdogan zachęca tureckie rodziny – zarówno w kraju, jak i na emigracji w Europie – aby miały minimum 3 dzieci. CDN.
