SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

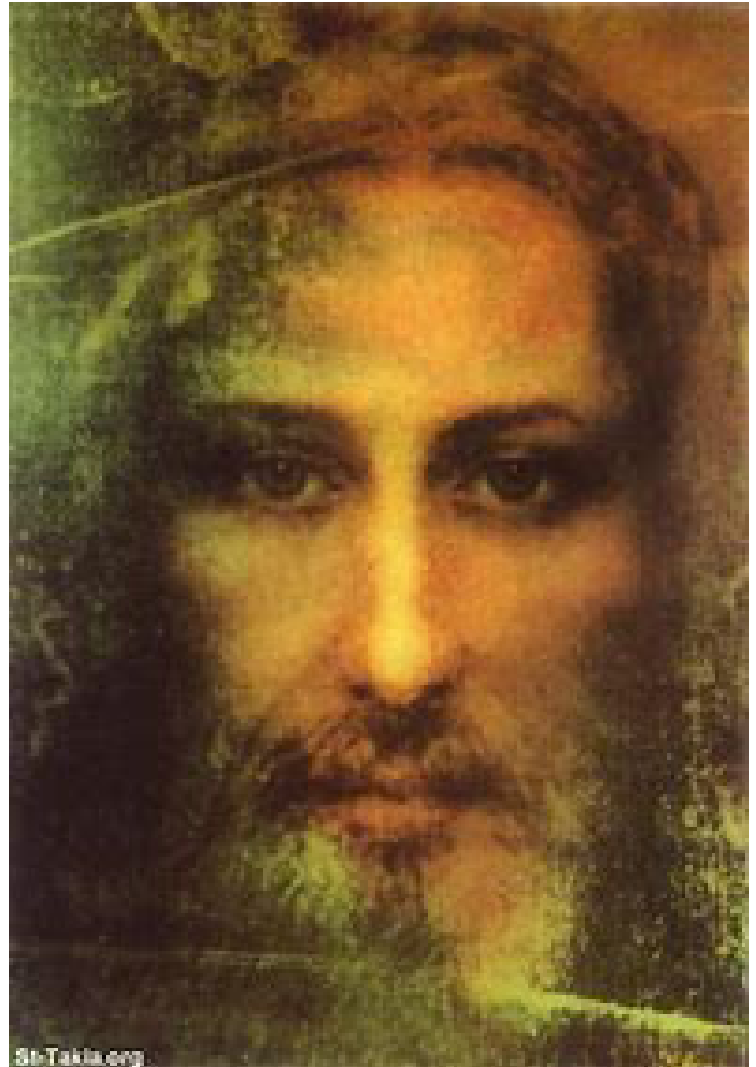

Lenten Fasting Regulations

Abstinence on all the Fridays of Lent, and fasting on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. No meat may be eaten on days of abstinence. Catholics 14 years and older are bound to abstain from meat. Invalids, pregnant and nursing mothers are exempt. Lent is a time of prayer, penance and almsgiving, intended to prepare us for the annual commemoration during Holy Week of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. These forty days can and should be a "springtime" for the soul: a time to rise from the death of sin and renew ourselves spiritually in preparation for the wondrous feast of Easter.

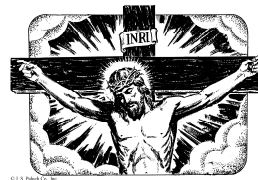

DROGA KRZYŻOWA—PIĄTKI GODZ.

WYCIAGAJA RECE PO NASZE DZIECI

Przez Europę przetacza się fala dyskusji o ideologii gender, której zatrute owoce tak ochoczo spożywają zac zadzone nią „postępowe” społeczeństwa, zwłaszcza zachodnie. Zwolennicy genderyzmu, czyli mutacji marksizmu, zaatakowali rodzinę i naturalny podział ze względu na płeć. Teraz zaś wyciągają ręce po najmłodszych, po nasze dzieci

Termin „gender” pochodzi z języka angielskiego i oznacza płeć (żeńską, męską) oraz rodzaj w gramatyce (męski, żeński i nijaki). Określenie to na stałe weszło do języka antropologów kulturowych specjalizujących się w tzw. gender studies, którzy — mówiąc w skrócie — twierdzą, że istnieje płeć kulturowa i każdy ma prawo wybrać, kim chce być: kobietą, mężczyzną lub „obojnakiem”.

Cel — rewolucja społeczna i obyczajowa

Definicja „gender”, choć wielu wydaje się niezwykle skomplikowana, prowadzi do jednej najważniejszej konkluzji: rewolucji społecznej i obyczajowej, której bronią jest promocja LGBTQ, czyli wszelkich dewiacji seksualnych. Promocja ideologii gender jest dążeniem do zniszczenia wzorów ról społecznych kobiet i mężczyzn, zaprzeczeniem wrodzonej naturalnej płciowości, otwarciem na wszelkie formy zбочeń, dążeniem do zniszczenia możliwości powstawania naturalnych zdrowych rodzin tworzonych przez ojca i matkę, a w końcu do zniszczenia całego społeczeństwa. Tak więc ideologia gender jest zjawiskiem znacznie bardziej niebezpiecznym, niż podają to liberalne media.

Aktywiści zaszczepiający gender w Unii Europejskiej starają się wpływać głównie na dzieci i młodzież, gdyż ta grupa jest dla nich najłatwiejszym łupem. Propagują program „Równościowe Przedszkole”, w którym dzieciom w imię wolności i równości usiłuje się narzucić kaganiec zniewolenia, zniekształcone wyobrażenie o świecie i bunt wobec norm, autorytetów i rodziców .
