SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:

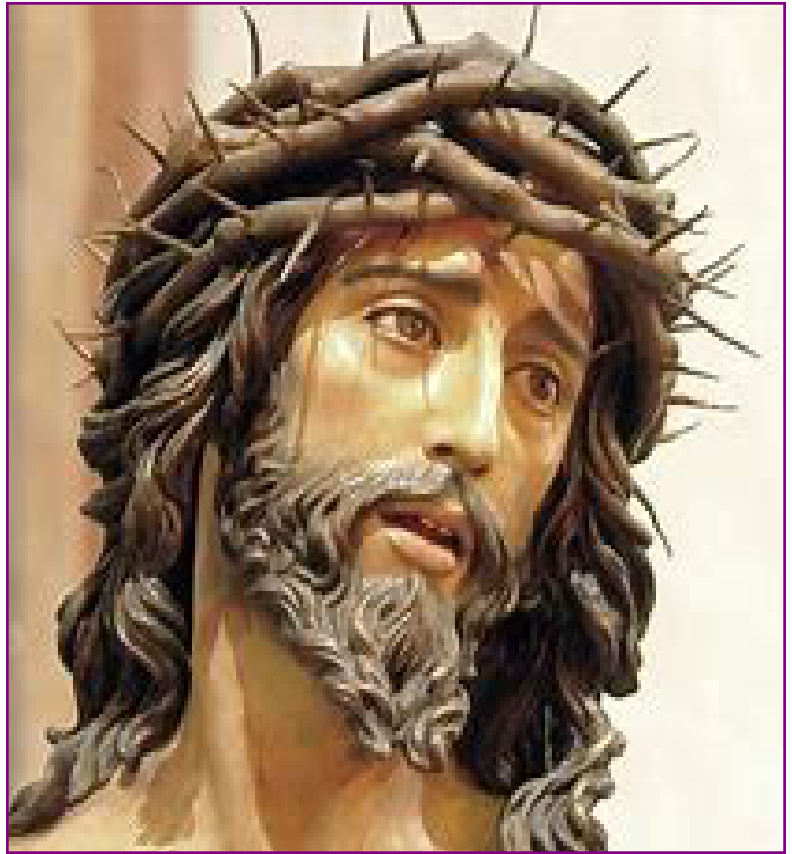

Lenten Fasting Regulations

Abstinence on all the Fridays of Lent, and fasting on Good Friday. No meat may be eaten on days of abstinence. Catholics 14 years and older are bound to abstain from meat. Invalids, pregnant and nursing mothers are exempt. Lent is a time of prayer, penance and almsgiving, intended to prepare us for the annual commemoration during Holy Week of Jesus' Passion, Death and Resurrection. These forty days can and should be a "springtime" for the soul: a time to rise from the death of sin and renew ourselves spiritually in preparation for the wondrous feast of Easter.

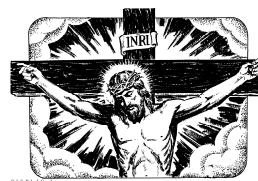

DROGA KRZYŻOWA—PIĄTKI GODZ.

WYCIAGAJA RECE PO NASZE DZIECI /2/

Zależność między gender a seksualizacją dzieci jest porażająca i oznacza działania w celu rozbudzenia niskich instynktów. Można to zaobserwować w poradnikach dla nauczycieli przedszkolnych. Osoby LGBT (skrótowiec odnoszący się do lesbijek, gejów, osób biseksualnych i transgenderycznych), mające problem z seksualnością, usiłują wskazać, że są rzekomo krzywdzone przez większość społeczeństwa myślącą zgodnie z prawem naturalnym. Genderyści chcą zmienić podręczniki szkolne dla dzieci i młodzieży tak, aby zostały dostosowane do ich upodobań. Najpierw zaatakowali rodzinę, a teraz wyciągają ręce po najmłodszych. Trwa walka o szkołę, w której fanatyczni ideolodzy posługują się kłamstwem i manipulacją. W mediach cechuje ich zjadła nienawiść do wszystkich, którzy ośmielają się myśleć inaczej i przeciwstawiać genderowej fali. Przekonują się o tym zwłaszcza francuscy i niemieccy rodzice, którzy nie godzą się na demoralizację swoich dzieci. Poddawani są oni zastraszaniu, a nawet odbiera im się dzieci, w czym specjalizuje się m.in. niemiecki Jugendamt. Potrzebna jest czujność, bo fala tej ideologii dotarła także do naszego kraju.

Chrześcijaństwo — wróg „postępu”

Ale jest jeszcze inna twarz tego problemu. Genderyzm to obecnie główna ideologia ateistów, to nowe wcielenie skompromitowanego marksizmu, którego nie dało się dalej głosić — uległ zatem przepoczwarzeniu i tak powstała ideologia gender, która nie znosi sprzeciwu i chrześcijaństwa. Z pomocą w redefinicji „czerwonych” pojęć przyszła filozoficzna szkoła frankfurcka, stosująca te same prymitywne schematy marksistowskie dotyczące podziałów i wynikających z nich konfliktów. Istotą takiego podejścia stanowi próba wyjaśnienia rzeczywistości za pomocą światopoglądu ateistycznego. Cdn/.
